<u>Solid Waste</u> (household trash, furniture) - \$85.00/ton - **Minimum Charge -** \$20.00 up to 460 lbs **Single Residential Bags Household Trash** (up to 39 gallon bag) \$2.00/per bag **Senior Citizen (60 and over with proof of age) Bags** (Up to 39 gallon bag) \$.50/per bag

<u>Construction & Demolition Debris</u> (debris from home improvements: wood, sheetrock, flooring, etc.) - \$85/ ton - **Minimum Charge** \$20.00/up to 460 lbs. **Large loads of C & D** \*\* **NEW HAMPTON TRANSFER STATION ONLY**\*\*

<u>Yard Waste (leaves, grass, branches)</u> \*\*NEW HAMPTON TRANSFER STATION ONLY\*\* \$40.00/ ton. **Minimum** \$20 for up to 460 lbs. of yard waste

Scrap Metal - \$60.00/ton Minimum \$15 up to 460 lbs. (washers, dryers, stoves, etc.) Air Conditioners, Refrigerators, Freezers, Dehumidifiers - \$15.00 per appliance Propane Tanks - \$2.00 per tank (must be empty)

Tires - \$200.00/ ton (more than 10) Tires in excess of 24" - \$600 per ton

Passenger Tires off the rims - \$2.00 - \$6.00 each based on size (on rims, extra charge)

Bicycle Tires - All sizes .25¢ each Motorcycle Tires - All sizes .75¢ each

\*\*NO CONSTRUCTION EQUIPMENT TRACKS, SOLID INDUSTRIAL TIRES, FORKLIFT TIRES OR FOAM FILLED TIRES WILL BE ACCEPTED\*\*

<u>Electronic Recycling</u> – \*\*NEW HAMPTON & NEWBURGH ONLY\*\* TV's are \$5.00 each until 12/31/17. **Due to rising costs, as of 1/1/18 TVs will cost \$10 each**. Computers, monitors and other computer peripherals, small scale servers, printers, scanners, fax machines, stereos and stereo equipment, cables and power adaptors, video game consoles, cable boxes, VCRs, DVRs, DVD players, digital media players, digital storage devices, laptops, tablets, e-readers, and smart phones & cell phones **WILL BE ACCEPTED FOR FREE**.

<u>Electronic Items NOT accepted as recycling</u> - alkaline batteries, small appliances and vacuum cleaners are considered solid waste, smoke alarms and carbon monoxide detectors (see website for disposal information), broken CRT glass (solid waste), and light bulbs (recycle CFL bulbs at Home Depot or Lowes).

<u>The following items are free to recycle at all Orange County Transfer Stations</u>: Paper, cardboard, plastic, cans, glass, motor oil, and antifreeze.
