During the month of October 2025, the Town of Chester Police Department responded to 17 animal complaints and investigated 5 motor vehicle crashes involving a deer. A breakdown of the complaints for the month is included below:

- 6 of the calls for service were for loose, lost or found dogs
- 5 of the calls for service were for an injured or deceased deer
- 2 of the calls for service were for sick or injured raccoons
- 1 of the calls for service was from a person unable to care for a dog
- 1 of the calls for service was for a barking dog
- 1 of the calls for service was for a lost cat
- 1 of the calls for service was for a bear sighting
