

TOWN OF CHESTER WATER DEPT.

MONTHLY REPORT- NOVEMBER 2025

The water department processed and distributed 5,829,208 gallons of water for the month of November. The districts daily average ranged from 176 to 69,000 gallons. The breakdown is:

Lake Hill Farms - 2,080,000 gal.

Walton Lake Estates – 951,600 gal.

Sugar Loaf - 1,247,500 gal.

Surrey Meadows - 1,213,300 gal.

Town Hall – 5308 gal.

Fieldcrest – 331,500 gal. (Distribution only)

Distribution sampling by us as well as random sampling by Orange County DOH showed adequate disinfection levels, and tested negative for any type of bacteria.

Monthly DOH 360 forms and test results for 10/2025 on all districts were submitted to DOH on 11/17/25

Laboratory testing dates were 11/5 & 11/19

Bulk chemicals were delivered on the 11/

Shut the water off to the parks 11/12

Had a class in Wallkill 11/13

Had OCHD inspections at all the Plants and sites 11/9 & 11/20

Greens of Chester started running new water main to connect to Village.

Other Business:

Sugar Loaf was mostly quiet with routine operations and maintenance.

Surrey Meadows was mostly quiet with routine operations and maintenance. Installed the new Cl2 monitor at the plant.

Lake Hill Farms was mostly quiet with normal operations and maintenance. Had the access road mowed between lake hill and windridge.

Walton Lake Estates was mostly quiet with routine operations and maintenance. There was a water main break on Maple In on election day, had help from highway dept with repairs.

Fieldcrest was quiet with routine operations and maintenance.
