**RE: Report of Police Department for November 2025**

The Town of Chester Police Department remained active in the community in November. We continued to maintain our objective of community commitment, while taking a proactive stance towards detecting crime and enforcing the laws. In November, the police department responded to **246 calls for service**. Officers drove **15,529 miles** during the month.

A breakdown of the criminal and non-criminal activity for the month is included below:

### CRIMINAL ACTIVITY

The Town of Chester Police Department made **6 arrests** during the month. A summary of the arrests is as follows:

- 1 arrested on an outstanding bench warrant
- 3 charged with Operating a motor vehicle with a Suspended Driver License
- 1 charged with Endangering the Welfare of a Child and Harassment in the second degree
- 1 charged with Dog at Large

### NON-CRIMINAL ACTIVITY

In addition to the arrests listed above, officers also responded to other calls for service in November. A summary of those calls for service is as follows:

- 25 medical calls
- 18 residential & commercial burglary or fire alarms
- 14 domestic disputes, disturbances, fights, or other disputes
- 10 reports of suspicious persons, vehicles or activity
  
- 2 motor vehicle crashes with injuries
- 2 motor vehicle crashes without injuries
- 4 motor vehicle crashes involving deer

# COMMUNITY POLICING

During the month, Town of Chester police officers assisted members of the community in many ways. Some of the community policing activity is listed below.

Officers completed **7 house security checks and 1059 business security checks** in November.

Sergeant Dugan and Officers Bird, Weinstein, Stack and Narain continue to complete child passenger safety seat checks and installations when needed.

Officer Stack maintained contact with the Chester Golden Age Club. He is working on another presentation to the group with the assistance of Village of Chester PD Detective Grosso.

Officer Dunlop maintained contact with the Bruderhof Bellvale Community. They requested assistance with some holiday events in December.

# TRAINING

Departmental monthly training was held on November 12<sup>th</sup> at the Chester Elementary School. A makeup session for the mandatory townwide training was also held at the station on November 12<sup>th</sup>.

# MISCELLANEOUS

Officers were assigned to the high school football game at the Chester Commons Park on November 1<sup>st</sup>.

Officers made periodic checks on the polling places during Election Day on November 4<sup>th</sup>. An officer was assigned to transport the election bags to the Board of Elections at the close of the polls.

Chief Doellinger and on-duty officers attended the community Veterans' Day services at the Main Street firehouse on November 11<sup>th</sup>.

Chief Doellinger attended a Community Breakfast at the Fox Hill Bruderhof community on November 18<sup>th</sup>.

Commercial vehicle enforcement details were held on November 4<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> with the NYS Department of Transportation. Twelve vehicles were inspected and five unsafe vehicles were taken out of service with major violations.

Officer Dunlop and K9 Lou performed explosives detection sweeps in Woodbury on November 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup>.

School Resource Officers Santosky-Wright, DeLuca and Donato were assigned to the Chester Academy and Chester Elementary Schools in November.

There were 238.25 hours of overtime paid in November.

Part-time police officers were used for 216 hours of patrol coverage (212 regular hours and 4 overtime hours).
