LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF 2021 A LOCAL LAW ADDING CHAPTER 66 ENTITLED "NOISE POLLUTION CONTROL" TO THE TOWN CODE OF THE TOWN OF CHESTER

Section 1. Title

This Local Law Shall be referred to as "A Local Law Adding Chapter 66, Entitled "Noise Pollution Control," to the Town Code of the Town of Chester

Section 2. Legislative Intent

The Town Board of the Town of Chester has determined that it is in the best interest of the Town to establish and impose restrictions upon the creation of excessive, unnecessary or unusually loud noise within the limits of the Town of Chester. It is the intention of the Town Board of the Town of Chester that these restrictions shall further secure and promote the public health, comfort convenience, safety, welfare, prosperity and peace and quiet of the Town of Chester and its residents.

LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF 2021 A LOCAL LAW ADDING CHAPTER 69 ENTITLED "OUTDOOR LIGHTING" TO THE TOWN CODE OF THE TOWN OF CHESTER

Section 1. Title

This Local Law shall be referred to as "A Local Law Adding Chapter 69, Entitled "Outdoor Lighting", to the Town Code of the Town of Chester.

Section 2. Legislative Intent

The Town of Chester has determined that it is in the best interest of the Town to have outdoor lighting policies in place to increase safety, provide security and enhance the nighttime character of the Town. It has been determined that new lighting technology has produced lights that are extremely powerful and when improperly installed, these lights create problems of excessive glare, light trespass and increased energy usage. Excessive glare may cause safety issues and light trespass reduces privacy and results in higher energy costs.

It is the intent of this local law to provide guidelines, regulations and standards for outdoor lighting so as to contribute to the safety and welfare of the Town and Town residents. It is the further intent of this local law to reduce problems created by improperly designed and installed outdoor lighting in an effort to eliminate excessive glare, reduce light trespass and help reduce the energy costs of outdoor lighting.

8920. Resident Fare: \$4.00 each way Senior/Persons with Disabil-
ities: \$2.00 each way. Stops throughout Chester & Goshen, in-
cluding Coach Bus Depots. Regularly scheduled stops on Tues-
days and Thursdays at Chester ShopRite. Special stop at Quick
Check in Florida. Transfers available in Warwick for Mid-
dletown.

BURNING OF BRUSH AND LEAVES

Brush and leaves are **NOT** allowed to be burned from March 16th
through May 14th annually. A local permit is not required. Refer
to NYS Dept. of Environmental Conservation 6 NYCRR Part 215.2
for detailed information, prohibitions, exceptions and re-
strictions.

BRUSH DISPOSAL

Brush, which includes branches and twigs up to 8" wide, can be
disposed of at the Town of Chester Highway Garage, 77 Laroe
Road. **NO LEAVES or GRASS CLIPPINGS ALLOWED!** Permit is free
to all residents and may be obtained Monday-Friday, 7:30—3:30
pm.

E-RECYCLING DROP OFF & BULK PICK UP

PEDDLING, SOLICITING & DO NOT KNOCK REGISTRY

A Local Law amending & replacing Chapter 71 entitled "Peddling and
Soliciting" of the Code of the Town of Chester, said Chapter to be
renamed "Peddling, Soliciting and Do Not Knock Registry" was enact-
ed by the Town of Chester in 2018. This local law prohibits peddling
and the soliciting of Chester Town residents who register with the
Town Clerk. A window cling indicating enlistment on the "Do Not
Knock Registry" may also be purchased for \$2.50. For more infor-
