

TOWN OF CHESTER
A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT
INTRODUCTORY LOCAL LAW 3 OF 2024
A LOCAL LAW TO ESTABLISH A CONSERVATION ADVISORY COUNCIL
PURSUANT TO GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW § 239-X.

WHEREAS, Article 12, § 239-x of the General Municipal Law authorizes a Town Board to establish a Conservation Advisory Council for purposes of advising the Town in the development management and protection of its natural resources;

WHEREAS, the Town Board desires to establish such council and set forth the powers and duties of the Chester Conservation Advisory Council; and

WHEREAS, INTRODUCTORY LOCAL LAW 3 OF 2024, A LOCAL LAW TO ESTABLISH A CONSERVATION ADVISORY COUNCIL PURSUANT TO GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW § 239-X was introduced before the Town Board of the Town of Chester on March 13, 2024, and

WHEREAS, a duly noticed public hearing was held on April 10, 2024.

WHEREAS, the Town Board determined that Local Law 3 of 2024 is a Type II action under SEQR and no further environmental review was required.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Board hereby adopts INTRODUCTORY LOCAL LAW 3 OF 2024 as Local Law 5 of 2024; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk shall cause the same to be filed with the New York State Department of State.
