**RE: Report of Police Department for January 2025**

The Town of Chester Police Department remained active in the community in January. We continued to maintain our objective of community commitment, while taking a proactive stance towards detecting crime and enforcing the laws. In January, the police department responded to **267 calls for service**. Officers drove **16,016 miles** during the month.

A breakdown of the criminal and non-criminal activity for the month is included below:

## CRIMINAL ACTIVITY

The Town of Chester Police Department made **13 arrests** during the month. A summary of the arrests is as follows:

- 1 charged with Criminal Obstruction of Breathing and Harassment in the second degree
- 1 charged with Criminal Contempt in the first degree and Harassment in the second degree
- 1 charged with Driving While Intoxicated and felony Operating a vehicle with a Suspended Driver License
- 1 charged with Criminal Mischief in the third degree and Emergency Admission of the Mentally Ill
- 8 charged with Operating a motor vehicle with a Suspended Registration or Suspended Driver License
- 1 taken into custody for Emergency Admission of the Mentally Ill.

## NON-CRIMINAL ACTIVITY

In addition to the arrests listed above, officers also responded to other calls for service in January. A summary of those calls for service is as follows:

- 35 medical calls
- 24 residential, commercial or automatic fire alarms
- 11 reports of suspicious persons, vehicles or activity
- 8 domestic complaints, disputes, disturbances or mental health crises
  
- 2 motor vehicle crashes with injuries
- 25 motor vehicle crashes without injuries
- 6 motor vehicle crashes involving deer

## COMMUNITY POLICING

During the month, Town of Chester police officers assisted members of the community in many ways. Some of the community policing activity is listed below.

Officers completed **9 house security checks** and **1099 business security checks** in January.

Sergeant Dugan and Officers Bird, Weinstein, Stack and Narain continue to complete child passenger safety seat checks and installations when needed. There were two seat checks completed in January.

Officer Stack remained in contact with Senior Center staff and members of the seniors' group.

## TRAINING

Monthly training was held in our training room on January 14<sup>th</sup>. The topic was our annual Taser recertification.

Officer Calderone instructed in the Use of OC Spray on January 16<sup>th</sup> and Patrol Rifle on January 31<sup>st</sup> at the police academy.

Officer DeLuca instructed in Bloodborne Pathogens at the police academy on January 23<sup>rd</sup>.

## MISCELLANEOUS

A commercial vehicle enforcement detail was held on January 22<sup>nd</sup> with the NYS Department of Transportation. Three vehicles were inspected and one unsafe vehicle was taken out of service with major violations.

We continued to provide School Resource Officers to the Chester Union Free School District. Officers Perez, DeLuca and Donato were assigned to provide coverage at the Chester Academy and the Chester Elementary School.

There was one letter of thank you received for the actions taken at a medical call. A copy of the letter is attached.

## SCHEDULING

There were 143 hours of overtime paid in January.

Part-time police officers were used for 196.5 hours of patrol coverage (196.5 regular hours and 0 overtime hours).
