During the month of June 2025, the Town of Chester Police Department responded to 15 animal complaints and investigated 1 motor vehicle crash involving a deer. A breakdown of the complaints for the month is included below:

- 5 of the calls for service were for loose, lost or found dogs
- 3 of the calls for service were for injured or deceased deer
- 2 of the calls for service were for bear sightings
- 2 of the calls for service were for a loose dog attacking another dog
- 1 of the calls for service was for a found fawn
- 1 of the calls for service was for a snake in a backyard
- 1 of the calls for service was for an injured hawk
