

TOWN OF CHESTER WATER DEPT.

MONTHLY REPORT- MAY 2026

The water department processed and distributed 6,914,795 gallons of water for the month of May. The districts daily average ranged from 274 to 85,000 gallons. The breakdown is:

Lake Hill Farms- 2,648,000 gal.

Walton Lake Estates- 1,021,200 gal.

Sugar Loaf- 1,498,000 gal.

Surrey Meadows- 1,454,900 gal.

Town Hall- 8,495 gal.

Fieldcrest- 284,200 gal. (Distribution only)

Distribution sampling by us as well as random sampling by Orange County DOH showed adequate disinfection levels, and tested negative for any type of bacteria.

Monthly DOH 360 forms and test results for 4/2026 on all districts were submitted to DOH on 5/7/2026

Laboratory testing dates were 5/6 & 5/20

Mowing dates at the plants were 5/4, 5/12, 5/18, 5/26

Bulk chemicals were delivered on 5/7

Truck #3 got dropped of a Healey for Recalls

Joe and I helped flag for Highway dept for the week for Tar and Chip.

Other Business:

Sugar Loaf was mostly quiet with routine operations and maintenance. 10 Wright rd, we replaced the shut off key and riser with help from highway digging.

Surrey Meadows was mostly quiet with routine operations and maintenance. Continued installing endpoint throughout.

Lake Hill Farms was mostly quiet with normal operations and maintenance. Did some hydrant maintenance in Windridge. Set up new Chlorine monitor system at the plant.

Walton Lake Estates was mostly quiet with routine operations and maintenance. TAM came to install new booster pump system in plant, first they build a temporary system in order to remove the old system. Than completed the install of the new Tiger Flow booster system.

Fieldcrest was quiet with routine operations and maintenance.
