The above referenced NYSDOT project has started. The road work began on May 25th, 2026, and Portable Variable Message Signs (PVMS) have been placed in advance to advise motorists of the upcoming work. This project contains the following work:

- Milling and paving work along Rt 17M from Rt 207 in Goshen to Rt 94 in Chester, ramps at Rt 207, ramps at Rt 17 exit 124, and from Gilbert St in Monroe to the Rt 17 intersection in Harriman.
- Drainage structures cleaning, repair, and grate replacements.
- Signal Detection System upgrades at signalized intersections.
- ADA curb ramp and sidewalk replacements at various locations.

This project includes daily lane closures with the use of traffic cones, signs, and flaggers during the daytime Monday through Friday between 9am – 4pm. Asphalt milling and paving work, especially at intersections and ramps are anticipated to be performed Sunday through Thursday between 9pm – 6am. We do not anticipate significant traffic delays throughout the project. When the Contractor plans on beginning work at night and/or if there are any significant changes to the schedule, we will provide an update to you all.

In the next few weeks, the Contractor plans on continuing to mobilizing equipment, surveying the site, cleaning/repairing catch basins, and replacing existing curb ramps and sidewalk at various locations along Rt 17M.
