RE: Report of Police Department for June 2026

The Town of Chester Police Department remained active in the community in June. We continued to maintain our objective of community commitment, while taking a proactive stance towards detecting crime and enforcing the laws. In June, the police department reported **416 incidents**. Officers drove **15,912 miles** during the month.

A breakdown of the criminal and non-criminal activity for the month is included below:

CRIMINAL ACTIVITY

The Town of Chester Police Department made **14 arrests** during the month. A summary of the arrests is as follows:

- 9 charged with Operating a Motor Vehicle with a Suspended Driver License and/or Registration
- 1 charged with Felony Operating a Motor Vehicle with a Suspended Driver License
- 1 charged with Felony Assault in the second degree, Assault in the third degree and Harassment
- 1 charged with Petit Larceny and Criminal Possession of Stolen Property
- 1 charged with Criminal Contempt in the second degree
- 1 taken into custody for Emergency Admissions of the Mentally Ill

NON-CRIMINAL ACTIVITY

In addition to the arrests listed above, officers also responded to other calls for service in April. A summary of those calls for service is as follows:

- 43 medical calls
- 16 animal complaints
- 15 residential & commercial burglary or fire alarms
- 11 hazardous conditions
- 10 welfare checks
- 9 reports of suspicious persons, vehicles or activity

- 2 motor vehicle crashes with injuries
- 11 motor vehicle crashes without injuries
- 5 motor vehicle crashes involving deer

COMMUNITY POLICING

During the month, Town of Chester police officers assisted members of the community in many ways. Some of the community policing activity is listed below.

Officers completed **13 house checks and 884 business security checks** in June.

Chief Doellinger met with Adrienne from the Sugar Loaf Chamber of Commerce on June 25th to review logistics and issues with the Spring and Fall festivals.

Sergeant Dugan and Officers Bird, Weinstein, Stack and Narain continue to complete child passenger safety seat checks and installations when needed. There was one seat installed in June.

TRAINING

Departmental monthly training for June was held on June 9th in our training room. The topics were an overview of the camera system and a traffic stop procedure review including a practical workshop.

Chief Doellinger attended a presentation on Managing the Legal Risk of Using AI in Law Enforcement during the Mid-Hudson Association of Chiefs of Police meeting in Poughkeepsie on June 4th.

Officer Calderone assisted with firearms training on several days in June as an instructor at the Orange County Police Academy.

Officer Bird and Contino attended the UAS Operator Course in Oriskany on June 9th, 10th and 11th.

Semi-annual firearms qualifications continued in June.

MISCELLANEOUS

Commercial vehicle enforcement details were held on June 2nd and 16th with the NYS Department of Transportation. Four vehicles were inspected and three unsafe vehicles were taken out of service with major violations.

Chief Doellinger attended a meeting and tour of the Science of the Soul Study Center facility in the Town of Goshen on June 11th.

Officers assisted with after-hours locking and unlocking of the senior center during the third week of June when the Recreation staff was away on a trip.

Part-time police officer Miguele Amoresano was hired by the town board on June 24th.

School Resource Officers Santosky-Wright, Donato and Christiano were assigned to the Chester Academy and Chester Elementary Schools in June.

- SROs were assigned to attend field days at the Elementary School on June 12th and the Middle School on June 5th.
- SROs were assigned to attend the 5th Grade Moving Up Ceremony and Dance on June 18th and the 8th Grade Moving Up Ceremony on June 23rd.
- SROs and officers were assigned to the High School Graduation Ceremony on June 25th.

SCHEDULING

There were 261.25 hours of overtime paid in June.

Part-time police officers were used for 160 hours of patrol coverage (152 regular hours and 8 overtime hours).
