RE: Monthly Report for Animal Control for July 2026

During the month of July 2026, the Town of Chester Police Department responded to 20 animal complaints and investigated 4 motor vehicle crashes involving a deer. A breakdown of the complaints for the month is included below:

- 7 of the calls for service were for loose, lost or found dogs
- 4 of the calls for service were for injured or deceased deer
- 2 of the calls for service were for animals in a condemned residence
- 1 of the calls for service was for a bear sighting
- 1 of the calls for service was for loose horses
- 1 of the calls for service was for a possibly sick fox
- 1 of the calls for service was for a deceased goose
- 1 of the calls for service was for a dog bite
- 1 of the calls for service was for an injured hawk
- 1 of the calls for service was for a whistlepig stuck in a sports net
