Help Birds Migrate Safely

Fall migration has started and continues thru October.

Over 80% of migratory birds fly at night, using the moon and stars to guide their routes. Bright artificial lights and urban skyglow confuse birds, pulling them off course. Disoriented birds crash into tall buildings and windows, causing millions of bird deaths each year.

What we can do:

- 1) Turn off non-essential exterior & interior lights from 11pm to 6am.
- 2) When possible, use motion sensors for outdoor lighting.
- 3) Close blinds & curtains to stop indoor light from shining outside.
- 4) Select shielded/baffled lighting fixtures for outdoor use, so lights shine down, not up.
