RE: Report of Police Department for August 2026

The Town of Chester Police Department remained active in the community in August. We continued to maintain our objective of community commitment, while taking a proactive stance towards detecting crime and enforcing the laws. In August, the police department reported **487 incidents**. Officers drove **14,469 miles** during the month.

A breakdown of the criminal and non-criminal activity for the month is included below:

CRIMINAL ACTIVITY

The Town of Chester Police Department made **14 arrests** during the month. A summary of the arrests is as follows:

- 9 charged with Operating a Motor Vehicle with a Suspended Driver License and/or Registration
- 1 charged with Criminal Contempt 1st & 2nd degrees and Harassment in the 2nd degree
- 1 charged with Criminal Mischief in the 4th Degree
- 1 charged with Creating Unreasonable Noise
- 2 charged with Solicitation without a Permit
- 1 taken into custody on an outstanding bench warrant

NON-CRIMINAL ACTIVITY

In addition to the arrests listed above, officers also responded to other calls for service in August. A summary of those calls for service is as follows:

- 33 medical calls
- 17 residential & commercial burglary or fire alarms
- 17 reports of suspicious persons, vehicles or activity
- 16 animal complaints
- 11 welfare checks

- 4 motor vehicle crashes with injuries
- 13 motor vehicle crashes without injuries
- 4 motor vehicle crashes involving deer

COMMUNITY POLICING

During the month, Town of Chester police officers assisted members of the community in many ways. Some of the community policing activity is listed below.

Officers completed **12 house checks and 903 business security checks** in August.

Sergeant Dugan and Officers Bird, Weinstein, Stack and Narain continue to complete child passenger safety seat checks and installations when needed.

On August 12th, Officer Bird assisted the Village of Monroe PD with a Child Passenger Safety Seat event at Sacred Heart Church in their village. There were 28 seats replaced in vehicles during this event.

Officers were present on Route 94 to monitor traffic during the Tour de Goshen bicycle event on August 16th.

SRO Donato was present for the 6th grade orientation at the Chester Academy on August 24th.

SRO Santosky-Wright was present for the Pre-K/Kindergarten orientation at the Chester Elementary School on August 26th.

TRAINING

There was no training attended in August.

MISCELLANEOUS

A commercial vehicle enforcement detail was held on August 18th with the NYS Department of Transportation. During the detail, a personal injury motor vehicle crash occurred on Route 94 involving a commercial vehicle. The dump truck was inspected and fourteen violations were noted, with the vehicle being placed out of service and towed from the scene.

Part-time police officer Miguele Amoresano continued his field training in August.

SCHEDULING

There were 335.75 hours of overtime paid in August.

Part-time police officers were used for 237 hours of patrol coverage (218 regular hours and 19 overtime hours).
